## Poster Guidelines

Congratulations on the selection of your poster for presentation at the 2018 National Landcare Conference.

Please follow these guidelines to ensure your poster display has an effective impact at the conference.

### POSTER GUIDELINES

- Maximum poster size 1000mm (w) x 500mm (h)
- Orientation of your poster is Landscape
- The title of your poster should be at the top, in large letters to get the viewer's attention
- Posters should also display the authors, institutions of origin and contact details of the corresponding author (contacts details of co-authors optional)
- Your goal is to convey a clear message and support it with a compelling combination of images and short blocks of text
- All text on the objectives, methods, results and conclusions need to be kept brief
- Every element, including graphs and tables must be easily readable from a distance of 2 metres
- Consider how best to use colour, photos, charts and pictures to enhance the information

**Please bring your poster already printed as there will be no printing services available on site**

### DISPLAYING YOUR POSTER

- Each poster board will be numbered and a list will be available onsite with your reference number
- All posters will be displayed using adhesive velcro only which will be provided onsite
- Set-up and dismantle - Authors are fully responsible for the set up and dismantling of their poster according to the schedule below
- It is suggested that authors of accepted posters stand by their posters to be able to discuss your project and answer any questions from participants during all breaks

11 – 12 October 2018	All posters displayed
